- ◆ In 30 plus years as a dressage rider and instructor, Sherry Guess has trained horses and riders from the first time under saddle to Grand Prix.
- ◆ She is a USDF 'L' Program dressage judge, a USDF Bronze Medalist and a USDF Certified Instructor.
- ◆ Her teaching emphasizes rider biomechanics. Once the rider is aware of how to use their body, communication with the horse becomes easier and the basic principles of dressage can be applied with fewer misunderstandings and less stress to the horse.
- ◆ Sherry is currently the USDF Region 9 Director and serves on the USDF Executive Board.

- ◆ Served on the Oklahoma Dressage Society Board for six years, being President for the past four.
- ◆ Before moving to Oklahoma, she was active in the California Dressage Society.
- ◆ As an Executive Board member, she was Education Chairman and was instrumental in introducing Mary Wanless to the west coast. She has ridden and participated in the Instructor Training with Wanless for 20 years.
- ◆ Sherry was a participant in six USDF Instructor Seminars with Maj. Anders Lindgren, as well as riding in clinics with him for 10 years. She was also a participating instructor in Sally Swift's Instructor Program and Alumni Program for Centered Riding Instructors. She trained for seven years with Dennis Callin, then four years with Mette Rosencrantz, in addition to clinics with Beth Baumert, Lilo Fore and Steffen Peters, among others.
