2010 Rules

1. Rider must pay a one-time yearly membership fee of \$5 per horse per division to be considered for the Oklahoma Eventing Circuit Year End Awards. Fee not retroactive except for those who participated in the Feather Creek Farm Combined Test held February 27th, 2010. Riders must pay the membership fee the day of (before competing) or prior to the competition at which points are to be earned.
2. Champion and Reserve Champion prizes will be awarded to horse/rider combinations based upon points earned during the calendar year at horse trials or combined tests held at the following facilities – Feather Creek Farm, Gallery Farm, Lily Pond Estates, and Southern Hills Riding Academy. Year End Awards will be given for the following divisions: Preliminary, Training, Senior Novice, Junior Novice, Senior Beginner Novice, Junior Beginner Novice, Senior Starter, Junior Starter, Senior Green As Grass, and Junior Green As Grass.
3. Ribbons will be given for 1st-6th place.
4. Senior riders are 18 and over; Junior riders are under 18 years old as of January 1st.
5. No horse/rider combination will be awarded Champion or Reserve Champion in a level (regardless if junior/senior) more than twice per year.
6. Divisions Defined: **Dressage** – Prelim., Training, Novice, & Beg. Novice - Corresponding 2010 USEA tests, Starter & Green As Grass – Intro. Level test (walk/trot only); **Stadium Jumping** – Prelim. – 3’7”, Training – 3’3”, Novice-2’9”, Beg. Novice – 2’7”, Starter-2’, and Green As Grass – 18” crossbars; **Cross Country Jumping** – Preliminary – 3’7”, Training – 3’3”, Novice-2’9”, Beg. Novice – 2’7”, Starter-2’, and Green As Grass – 18”.
